1. **Principals:**
  - a. 2026 School Planning Presentation
    1. Video Shared from CBE "School Planning and You"
    2. School Development Plan - For Valley View we are in year 2 of 3
    3. Goal 1:
      - a. Student foundational skills, literacy, and mathematics will improve. Students will improve phonological awareness and decoding skills
      - b. This goal will be assessed through identified core vocabulary, mathematics screens, EAL benchmarks, teacher perceived data and asking students the same question three times per year for three data points & Actions
    4. Goal 2:
      - a. Students will implement a solution-focused problem solving approach, increasing their sense of safety and belonging. Students will develop and understand of self-awareness and learn skills to regulate.
      - b. This goal will be assessed through student perceptions of having regulation strategies and through report cards.
    5. Questions:
      - a. Is the plan in motion? Yes currently in year 2 of 3.

- b. How can the school council help? School council has helped a lot and readily available to help. School council has provided math carts, books, etc.
      - c. Any additional funds to plan for the upcoming year? Potentially using to casino funds in the future.
    - ii. School Budget. In 2025-2026 VVS has received \$4,053,898 at least 75% is spent on staffing. The remaining portion covers instructional and operational costs (\$111,863) This money is also used to hire additional support staff as needed.
    - iii. Central Fees vs School Based Fees. Central fees are lunch, transportation, etc, School based fees go to supplies and then field trip fees are in addition.
    - iv. 2026-2027 Fees are projected to be similar to this year, however these will be confirmed in August.
    - v. Reviewed the 2024-2025 School fee report. There was roughly \$3700 that needed to be paid by the school. If parents are able to pay fees later on the money will come back to the school.
    - vi. If families are unable to pay, families can apply for a central fee waiver for school fees, transportation fees, lunch supervision fees, etc.
    - vii. Completed a quick questionnaire on parent feedback to the SDP
  - b. Shafina Dharmasi:
    - i. Complexity Team:
      - 1. Resource Teacher, Mrs. Quinn was split .6 in resource and .4 in Kindergarten. The kindergarten teacher has moved to 1.0 fte and Ms Quinn will move to full time complexity teacher. She is working to make sure we have targeted intervention supports for students with complex needs.
      - 2. This will be ongoing for next year as well.
